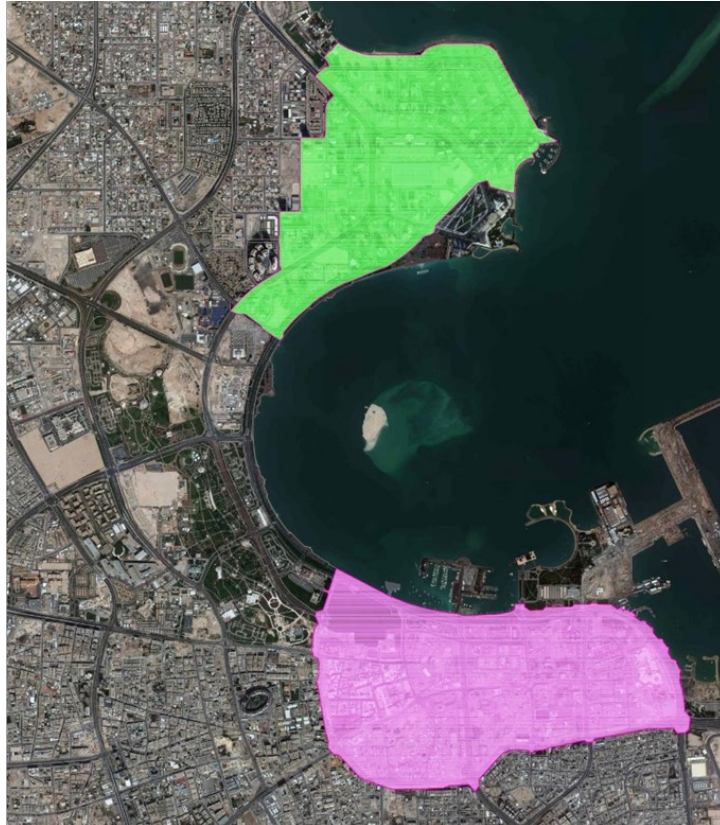

The Public Works Authority (“Ashghal”) is planning to implement the West Bay & Doha Central Car Parking Public Private Partnership Program and is seeking a private partner to Design, Build, Finance, Operate, Maintain and Transfer the car parks for a defined concession period (the “Project”)

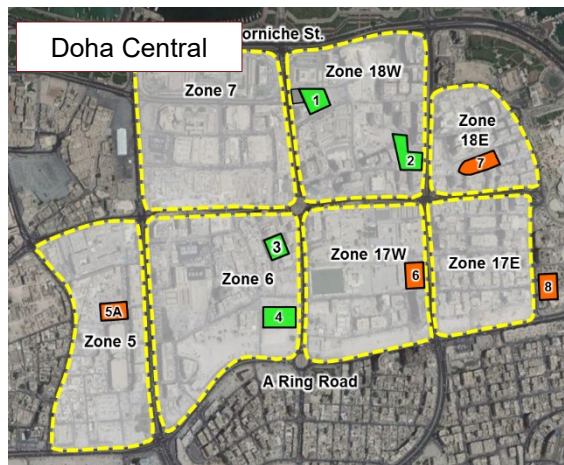

1. General Information

1.1 West Bay & Doha Central Car Parking PPP Program

The State of Qatar is committed to addressing the growing demand for public services, and in doing so is seeking innovative ways in which to deliver the required infrastructure. The Qatar National Vision 2030 highlights the significance of developing and enabling the private sector to play a key role in achieving the long-term goals and outcomes for the country. In particular, the use of Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) as means to develop its infrastructure and delivery of services.

In line with above objective, Ashghal has identified an opportunity for a private investor to Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Maintain and Transfer (“DBFOMT”) multiple on and off street car parking facilities within the Doha Central and West Bay areas, as indicated below. The Project is part of Doha’s beautification strategy with the purpose of reducing the cases of illegal on and off street parking, through the implementation of new, controlled and regulated parking facilities.



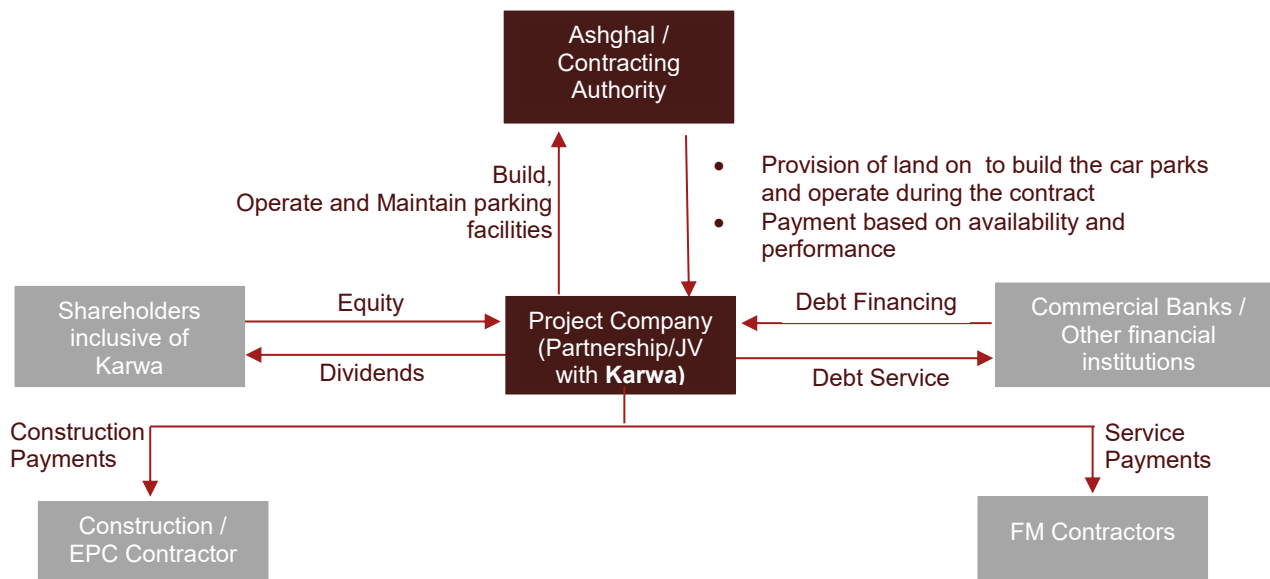
1.2 Invitation to Expression of Interest

The purpose of this Request for Expression of Interest is to invite competent Qatari and international companies and consortia capable of delivering the project to participate in the Project, and request them to indicate their interest in the Project by submitting an EOI.

1.2.1 Project Scope

- The Project scope will include the design, construction, financing, operation and maintenance of the defined on-street, surface and multi-storey off-street parking areas, as deemed necessary for delivering the objectives of the Project.
- Government will set-up high level project requirements including operational and quality standards, parking policies and fare structures etc.
- The private partner under the proposed commercial structure (defined further below) will be remunerated in the form of parking and retail revenues generated by the project with additional Government support.
- The parking facilities are expected to be operational by the end of 2021, ahead of the 2022 World Cup; which is a critical timeline target for the implementation of the Project. The length of the concession period for the operation and maintenance of the parking facilities is expected to be up to 25 years, but subject to revision if required.

- The land allocated to the parking facilities will be leased from the Government on nominal rent basis.
- The basic structure of the DBFMOT delivery model for the Project is illustrated below. Whilst the complete shareholding structure is not comprehensive at this stage, Mowasalat Company (Karwa), the Qatari based provider of public transportation services will be expected to have an ownership stake in the Project Company.

2. Capabilities required from the Private sector

The respondents to this EOI (the “Respondents”) shall note that within the Request for Qualification (“RFQ”) they shall be required to provide evidence of their experience with projects of a similar nature as the Project including reference projects that are operational and currently under construction. Projects should include both international and regional assignments wherever applicable.

The Respondent shall be requested to focus on projects conducted during the previous **five years** and on projects implemented internationally, in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) and in the Middle-East and North Africa (MENA) Region. In case of a consortium, the Respondent shall be required to clearly specify which of their consortium members have been involved in each of the case studies.

Interested parties to this EOI are recommended to have the below indicative criteria. Specific information on these criteria is expected to be included in the responses to the RFQ document and will be evaluated accordingly:

- Strong track record in development of car parks as design, built, finance, operate projects;
- Sufficient key personnel with demonstrated experience in similar size & specific technical experience;
- Technical abilities to meet the construction and operational requirement;
- International and Regional experience in participating in similar projects;
- Demonstrated ability to raise finance for similar projects; and
- Sound financial position.

3. EOI Submission Instructions

3.1 Expression of Interest

Ashghal is interested in receiving EOIs with the information sought in section 3.2 of this document from interested parties with a track-record of extensive and relevant experience in the design, build, finance, operation and maintenance of car parking facilities or similar projects.

Assuming that Ashghal proceeds with the RFQ stage, parties that submit an EOI will be notified of the RFQ stage and, where applicable, requested to obtain the RFQ documents (this stage will also be advertised to the market).

Ashghal understands that interested participants may wish to form a consortium to bid for the Project, but at the stage of this Request for EOI, interested companies and firms may respond individually and demonstrate the expertise of their primary activities.
